## Greenstar opens Ireland's largest automated Materials Recycling Facility



Greenstar's new Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) was officially opened by the Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, Dick Roche TD, on Monday 16 October. The facility was built in an investment worth €25 million and is located in Ballycoolin, north County Dublin. Called Millennium Park, the facility will recycle over 70% of the Commercial & Industrial (C&I) waste and more than 85% of the Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste it processes, thereby diverting 180,000 tonnes from landfill every year.

*The opening of Millennium Park will significantly increase the volume of commercial waste that can be diverted from landfill in the Dublin region.*

The Dublin region currently produces 670,000 tonnes of commercial waste per year with just 35% of this recycled rather than going to landfill or being exported for further treatment. Licensed to accept 220,000 tonnes of C&I and C&D waste per year, the Millennium Park facility could handle over a

third of the commercial waste produced in Dublin and recycle between 70-85%.

The opening of Millennium Park will significantly increase the volume of commercial waste that can be diverted from landfill in the Dublin region. As well as helping the region meet the recycling targets set out under the Dublin Waste Management Plan (2005), Millennium Park is also an important infrastructural asset and a response to the Plan's call for investment by the private sector in material recycling facilities.

Innovations at the facility include the application of best in class technology such as air separation / density separation technology permitting more effective recovery and a higher quality of material to be produced at the end of the process. It is an automated process, which increases the quality of the recyclable outputs and the percentage of the material diverted from landfill.

The facility is now fully operational and will be accepting waste from the Greater Dublin area.

### Greenstar wins Repak Recovery Operator of the Year – Large Company

Greenstar was delighted to be named as **Recycling Operator of the Year** (Large Company) in this year's Repak Recycling Awards held in late October.

As part of the annual Repak Recycling Week which ran until 8th October, the Awards highlighted companies that have contributed to the environment by minimising and recycling packaging waste. Greenstar recorded a 110% increase in its recycling of packaging waste such as metal, paper and plastic between 2004 and 2005, resulting in over 28,000 tonnes of waste being diverted from landfill.

The high recycling levels were greatly supported by the efforts of Greenstar's customer base who presented segregated waste for collection throughout the year.

Greenstar has been working for many years at developing initiatives aimed at managing waste more effectively and thereby reducing environmental impact and costs. The benefits are clearly being seen in the increased recycling levels that the industry as a whole is achieving and Greenstar is confident that this will continue in the future.

The award is testament to the investment Greenstar has made to improvements in its infrastructure and processing capacity of dry mixed recyclables which has enabled higher recycling rates through greater recycling focus and allowed for best practice in the processing of waste streams such as wet/food waste. Greenstar has also invested heavily in its internal reporting systems and now uses the most comprehensive waste management and fully traceable recycling reporting systems.

Greenstar prides itself as "setting the standard" in waste management. As part of our ongoing commitment to improve our services to our customers, we are delighted to be able to announce details of our new and improved domestic and kerbside recycling service.

Since Monday 4th December 2006, Greenstar has been providing a weekly domestic refuse collection service to our customers in the Bray, Greystones and Kilcoole areas. This means that our customers now receive four domestic collections instead of three per month. In addition, our customers will now receive two recycling collections per month - previously customers only received one.

It is planned to extend the service to the rest of our customers in Wicklow from 29th January 2007.

Over a year ago, Greenstar introduced the pay-by-use system of waste management which allowed our customers to significantly alter their waste management behaviour and reduce their waste bills. An analysis of our customer's bills, undertaken earlier in 2006, showed that the majority of Greenstar customers now pay less in waste management fees than they did two years ago.

Keith McCormack, Head of Marketing, Greenstar stated "Earlier in the year we asked some of our customers to participate in a survey where we undertook a review of the domestic and kerbside recycling collection. The aim of this review was to gain a better understanding of your recycling habits and more importantly your requirements of the service. The results of the survey came through loud and clear which was that our customers had changed their

recycling habits so dramatically that there was a requirement by many of them for an increase in the recycling collection frequency. In addition, many of you also asked for the flexibility of increased domestic waste collections".

We listened to what you had to say and took on board your requirements. But the best news of all is Greenstar will be offering these service improvements and increased frequencies **with no increase** in waste charges for customers who sign up or renew their domestic waste collection contract with us before 28th February 2007! That's an unbelievable offer! Not only can you manage your waste costs more effectively with Greenstar's pay-by-use system but we are offering you the opportunity to ensure that you only pay 2006 prices for the whole of 2007.
